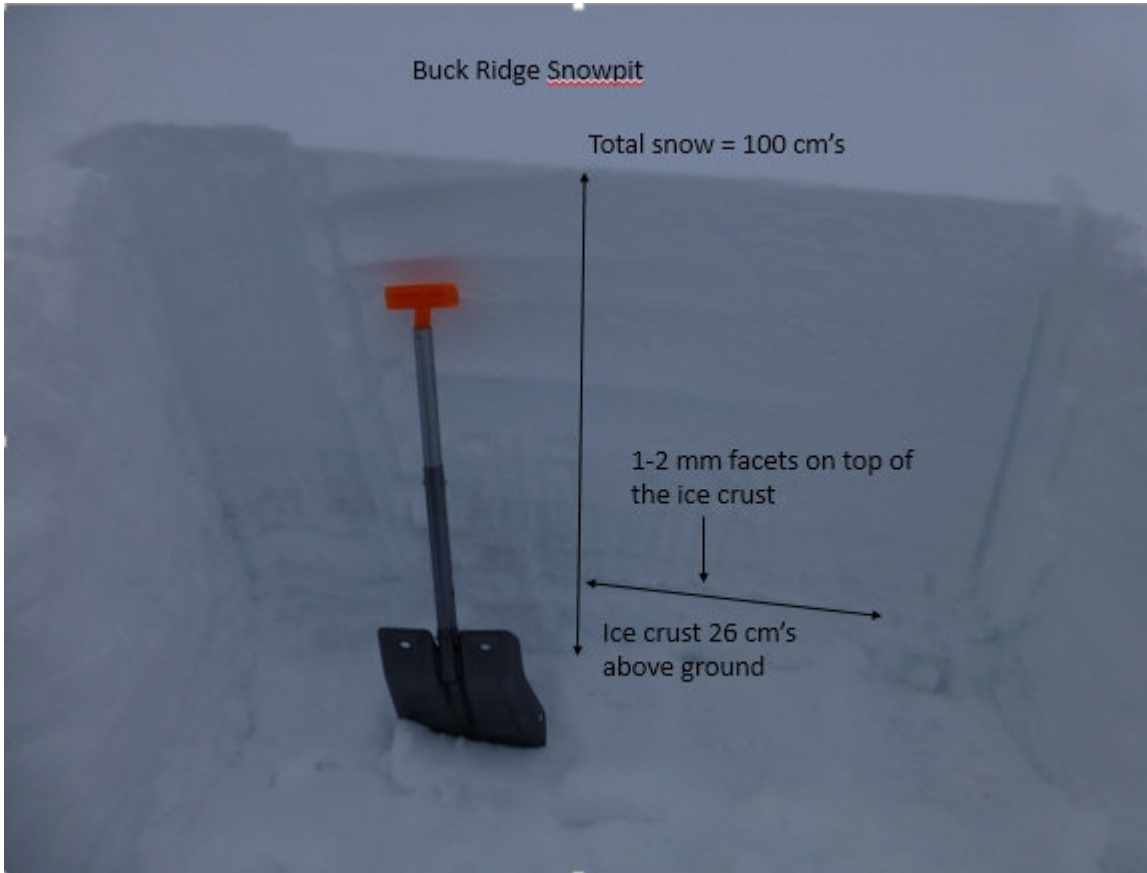




Buck Ridge Snowpit
