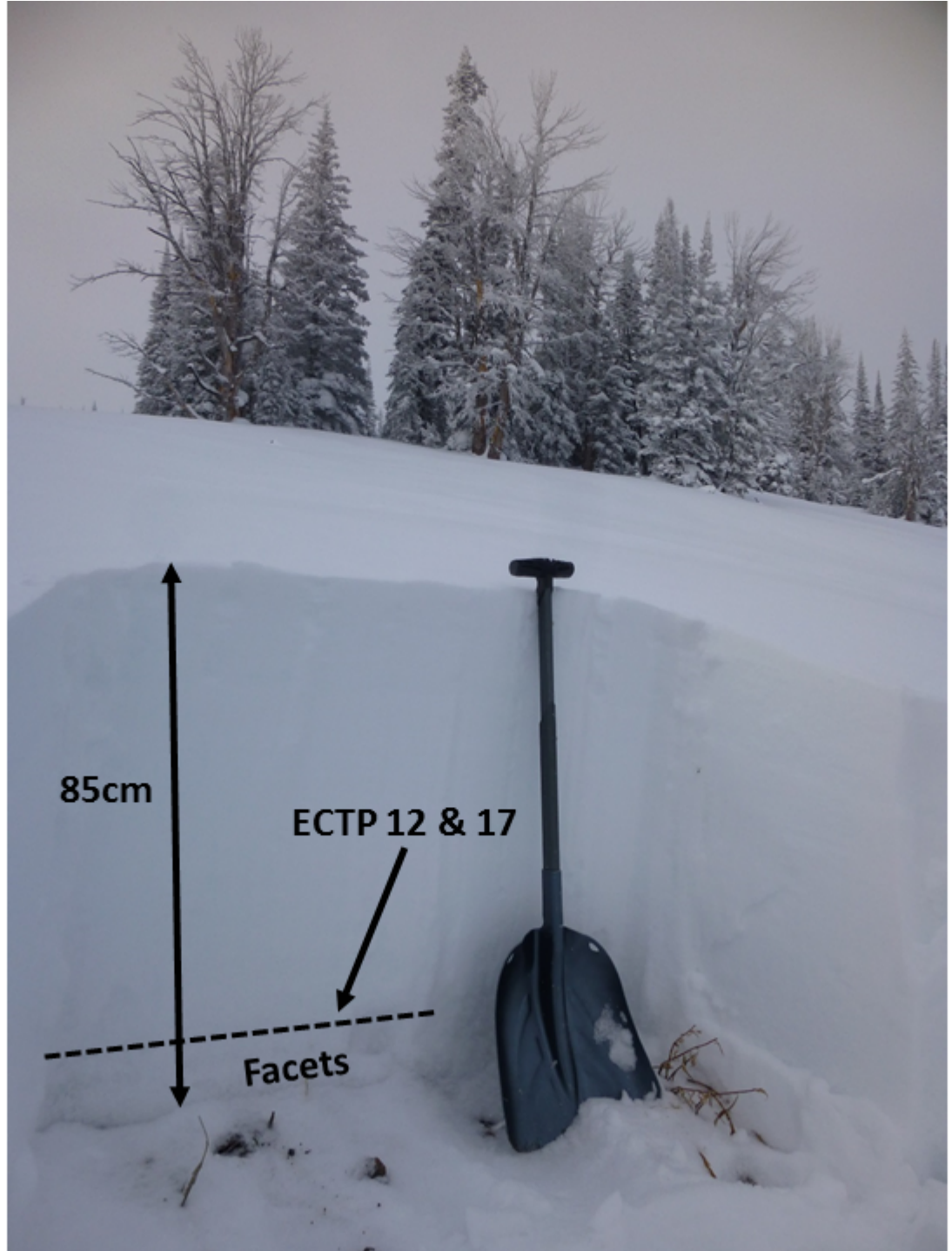




Depth Hoar at Bacon Rind



The bottom 15cm of the snowpack consisted of large depth hoar crystals (4+mm). As we skied up we heard one large collapse on this layer and in our snowpit this layer failed at ECTP12 and 17.
