From email: "This afternoon en route back to Livingston from Idaho, lots of slide activity at all elevations...

The first picture is the <u>cornice</u> <u>collapse</u>. One block in the debris pile was probably the size of my airplane - a giant ass snowball.

The next few photos are wet <u>slab</u> a mile north along the same ridge, location: approximately 1-2 miles SW of the coordinate photo (it took me a minute to get cords up). Elevation of both approximately 9,800-10,000.

Too many point releases to count in every range I've crossed today..."
